The _____ League is a singles scratch league that will consist entirely of male / female (circle which) bowlers from _____ High School. All bowlers in this league must be a certified as a regular team member of the school listed and be a member of one of the divisions of the Flint Metro Bowling Conference (FMBC) this season.

As the FMBC leagues certify 100% of its bowlers, all bowlers must be members of the Greater Flint USBC Youth Association and a student in good standing at their high school as well as meet the eligibility standards of the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA). This league will be governed by the Bowling Coach/es of this high school team as well as the Commissioners of the FMBC.

This league will bowl two / three (circle which) games each session as well as practice on their individual skills as time allows (block of time determined by the center involved). Sessions will be held on _____ at _____ pm. No individual is allowed to bowl on any day except during these scheduled times unless a scheduled make-up time is determined by the coach. Bowling on days when school is cancelled because of weather or any other extenuating circumstances will be determined by the Coach and School.

The league will start _____ (day & date) and finish no later than February 27, 2009. Games will be bowled at _____ (center name). In the case of those schools that compete at more than one center, games may also be bowled at _____ and _____.

There are no league fees as the bowling is provided by the metro Flint area Bowling Center/s.

Entering averages for regular team members will be based on the games bowled in their first appearance in the league. The entering average for Average Based Awards will be determined by rule 53 from the USBC Playing Rules.

A record of the wins/losses must be kept to declare an overall league champion. [A 7-point system will be used, two points for each game and one for series.]

Absentee score will be the absent bowler's average minus 10 pins.

Tardy players can make up frames if they arrive before the end of the 3rd frame. If they arrive after that frame they will not be allowed to bowl until the next complete game is started.

Any show of unsportsmanlike conduct (swearing, kicking ball return, fouling intentionally, etc.) WILL result in dismissal for the day. If it becomes a habit, bowlers will be asked to leave the league.
