

## *Coaches Duties and Responsibilities*

Responsibilities include the following:

- \*Conducting a minimum of 1 practice and a maximum of 2 practice sessions per week, approximately 2 hours long
- \*Accompany the team to all meets and tournaments
- \*Maintain discipline of the players, enforcing any penalties drawn by a player per rules and regulations
- \*Coach will present a legal lineup of players for all meets and present that lineup before the start of match play
- \*Complete knowledge and understanding of all rules set forth by the Michigan High School Bowling Conference
- \*Enforcing the rules as set forth by the MHSBC
- \*Verify scores after each game/match
- \*Verify academic eligibility of each team member weekly
- \*Provide bowling instruction, tips, information and encouragement in an effort to enhance each team member's bowling skills
- \*Obtain information regarding players for uniforms, biographies and/or scholarships
- \*Assist in obtaining or providing transportation to practices, meets and tournaments
- \*Assist in fund-raising activities
- \*Turn in sanctions to the commissioner on 1st meet (filled out entirely) for every bowler on the team and for every new bowler at their first meet
- \*Enforce the dress code-proper color slacks-no denim and shirts must be tucked in
- \*Any infraction of these said rules will result in disqualification of bowling and forfeiture of games
- \*Turn in all forms before the athletes bowl their first match
- \*Teach all bowlers bowling etiquette
- \*Define excused absences from practices and how it is determined who participates at meets
- \*Practices should be bowled as a team

### Conduct of Coaches

- 1-No coach or other person officially connected with the team shall be permitted to use any tobacco products on the bench or in the play or spectator area while competition is being bowled
- 2-No consumption of alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the bowlers' area or on the concourse while competition is being bowled
- 3-Coaches should remain with their team while the team is bowling at meets and matches
- 4-Coaches are to make sure their teams' bowlers are ready to bowl when is their turn
- 5-Unsportsmanlike conduct, including vulgar language or language not to the best interest of bowling is not permitted
- 6-Coaches are to treat conference members, including bowlers and officials, and spectators with respect
- 7-Coaches are to encourage & help their team members
- 8-The coach may be replaced for any infraction of YABA or Conference Rules at any time
- 9-Coaches should be in uniform-same as players on team
